September 2014

Spring started with a bang, with 2 days of 28 deg C temperature being recorded but we also experienced cool nights going down to a low of 6.1 deg C. Only 21.2 mm of rain was recorded for the whole of September.

October 2014

The first week in October saw a week of temperatures between 25 deg C and 31 deg C. Only 8mm of rainfall was recorded for the whole month resulting in perfect warm, dry conditions leading into flowering.

November 2014

The warmer days continued with a maximum of 31.4 deg C recorded while mean average temperature was 18.3 deg C with 21.4 mm of rain being recorded for the month. Wind speed recorded was lower than usual for November.

December 2014

Warm, dry weather continued throughout December with a high of 30.9 being recorded. Only 6.6mm of rainfall fell during the entire month.

January 2015

January saw the hot weather continuing with the highest temperature for the whole growing season of 32.4 deg C being recorded this month. The mean average temperature was 21.1 deg C with 19.8mm rainfall recorded. Harvesting started on Thursday the 22nd January 2015, our earliest recorded vintage in history at Jordan, and at least two weeks earlier than usual.
